The vineyard have different types of soil, this creates a balanced complexity, there are different types of both Cabernet Franc and Merlot for a wine with a deep and decisive taste.

Harvest:

Manual selection of the grapes, harvested in cases. The varieties ferment separately to evolve both at the right time before creating the blend.

Vinification:

Spontaneous fermentation and controlled temperatures, long maceration times based on the vintage, this gives the wine an intense and elegant body.

Ageing:

The wine rests in oak vats, these are particular in their assembly as they are made with untoasted woods to create a complex yet relaxing harmony in the final taste. The wine will mature for a minimum of another 6 months in the bottle.

Leafy, curranty cabernet aromas follow through to a medium-to full-bodied palate that adds juicy black-cherry fruit. The tannins are lightly firm but don't impede the expansion of the savory and fruity flavors. The finish is long, bright and tight. A judicious 50/50 blend of cabernet franc and merlot creates a stylish wine with a good degree of refinement and complexity. Drink or hold.
