Height 270 m.a.s.l

For us everything started with this vineyard and this wine, whose first vintage was 2011. Two half hectar vineyards, meticulously planned and planted in two different locations so as to be able to merge the best results of both into this wine. Our oldest vineyard.

Harvest:
Completely manual selection, collected in crates.
The harvest is divided by areas.

Vinification:
Spontaneous fermentation at a controlled temperature, the grapes from the different areas are kept separated during the vinification process so we are able to create the best possible blend when it comes to the final tasting; prioritizing the higher parts of the vineyard where the soil is dryer which gives us smaller grapes of the highest quality.

Ageing:
The ageing happens in cement vats which allow a natural breathing and evolution of the wine without imparting additional aromas thanks to the neutrality of the method used. The wine continues to rest as long as possible in the bottles which completes our wine.
